

Leonida Tedoldi, full professor, historian of political institutions and international relations, has taught History of European and International Institutions and currently teaches *History of International Relations, Political Conflicts and Democratization Processes*, and *Global Economy in Historical Perspective* at the University of Bergamo.

He is also a member of the Faculty of the School of Government at LUISS Guido Carli in Rome, of the Centro de investigación de historia de la democracia española (CIHDE) at UNED University in Madrid and of, Working Group Globalization and International Governance, Società italiana di Storia internazionale .

He has been an associate member and collaborator of the Centre d'Études des Normes Juridiques "Yan Thomas" at the École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales in Paris, and Deputy Director of the Center for Political Studies "Hannah Arendt" at the University of Verona. He is on the editorial board of the scientific journals "Le Carte e la Storia. Rivista di Storia delle istituzioni", "Spagna Contemporanea", and on the advisory board of the journal "Memoria y Pasado. Revista de Historia Contemporánea". He was also a member of the editorial board of "Storia Amministrazione Costituzione" (Class A) from 2005 to 2013.
