2 Short biography

Albachiara Boffelli followed a scientific training course, obtaining a master's degree in Management Engineering in 2014 with a thesis entitled "Sustainability paths of Italian textile companies: an empirical study", receiving full marks (110/110 cum laude).

In 2015, after a professional experience in a multinational company, she began her collaboration with the University of Bergamo as a research fellow, working on a project funded by the Pro Universitate Bergomensis, focused on the analysis of the Global Value Chain and the competitive dynamics of the textile and clothing sector.

In 2020, she obtained a doctorate in Economics and Management of Technology (DREAMT) as part of the joint program between the University of Bergamo and the University of Pavia. The doctoral thesis entitled "Exploring the reshoring process: advancing knowledge through primary and secondary case studies" explores the issue of reshoring, understanding the main phases of the process, using case studies and meta-synthesis and meta-analysis methodologies. As part of the PhD program, she carried out a research period abroad at Lund University (Sweden) under the supervision of Prof. Jan Olhager.

From October 2019 to September 2021, she was a research fellow at the University of Bergamo, working on the projects "Managing offshoring and reshoring decision: a meta-analysis research", developed starting from her PhD, and "Sustainability, technology and organization in manufacturing firms".

Since October 2021 till December 2022, she has been a Junior Assistant Professor (RTD-A) at the University of Bergamo, lecturing the courses of Sustainable and Global Supply Management, Management of Global Enterprises and General Business Administration and Logistic Systems Management. Since December 2021, she has been a board member of the School of Management of the University of Bergamo. She earned the Italian National Habilitation for Associate Professor in October 2022, and, since January 2023, she has been a Senior Assistant Professor (RTD-B) at the University of Bergamo. Between June and July 2023 she spent a visiting period at the University of Manchester (UK).

Along the academic path, she has participated in numerous conferences and seminars. In particular, she participated in the EDEN Doctoral Seminar on research methodology in Operations Management organized by EIASM; two international doctoral workshops (organized by the EurOMA association); three national summer schools on Complexity, Research Design and Teaching (in 2016, 2017 and 2019); editions from 2016 to 2021 of the EurOMA conference; 2017 and from 2020 to 2023 editions of the International EurOMA Sustainable Operations and Supply Chains Forum; from 2019 to 2023 editions of the Annual EDSI Conference, from 2019 to 2022 editions of the Annual DSI Conference; 2021 edition of IPSERA; from 2016 to 2022 editions of the Annual Scientific Meeting of the Italian Association of Management Engineering (AiIG). On these occasions, she presented numerous scientific articles written with the research groups she collaborates with (detailed in the Publications section).

6 Scientific activity

6.1 Research areas

During her academic career, Albachiara Boffelli has developed research activities on various topics and scientific fields of interest for the Management Engineering discipline. In particular, her research activity is part of the macro-area of Operations and Supply Chain Management and has developed in four main areas:

1. Theme 1 - Reshoring and manufacturing location decisions:

Reshoring is a fairly recent trend in location decisions involving companies relocating their manufacturing activities either backshore or nearshore. The research activity developed in this area first entailed the identification of the major gaps in the literature through an in-depth review of the same. Subsequently, the research was developed around decision-making issues and the implementation of backshoring decisions by applying the multiple case study methodology. Furthermore, in this context, innovative methodologies for Operations and Supply Chain Management, such as meta-synthesis and case survey, have been tested. The doctoral thesis and the activity of the immediately following research fellowship mainly focused on this topic. Among the publications listed in the list in this document, the following are related to the first theme: 2, 3, 4, 7, 9, 10, 12, 15, 21, 25, 26, 28, 31, 32, 33, 35, 36, 37, 39, 41, 43, 56, 59, 60, 65, 68.

2. Theme 2 - Global Value Chain:

The Global Value Chain framework is well known by scholars of economic geography and international business, but it is still generally ignored in the field of Supply Chain Management. However, it represents a fascinating perspective for analyzing a supply chain in a context of global fragmentation and dispersion of activities. The research activity related to this topic was developed in relation to:

- the identification of upgrading paths, strictly correlated to the innovation strategy, of the companies analyzed with the framework of the Global Value Chain (publications 45, 53, 54, 55, 63, 75);
- understanding the interdependencies between local clusters and the Global Value Chain they belong to (publications 16, 46);
- the exploration of the relationships existing between the different concepts of the Global Value Chain: upgrading, governance and participation in the Global Value Chain (publications 13, 50, 51);

- smiling curve theory in the context of a developed country by analyzing the upgrading paths of companies (publications 47, 61, 62).

3. Theme 3 – Sustainable Supply Chain Management and Circular Economy:

The research on the issue of sustainability was first developed on the analysis of the strategies and practices of environmental sustainability of Italian textile companies. This topic was developed using the survey methodology. The results of this study are reported in publications 11, 48, 52, 76, 77. Subsequently, the links between environmental sustainability and lean management philosophy were addressed, studied in publications 14, 49. Today, the theme has evolved towards a perspective oriented to Operations and Supply Chain Management and the main trends in sustainability (e.g. Social sustainability, Circular economy, New technologies for traceability). The publications 1, 17, 18, 21, 22, 23, 30, 40, 42, 44, 58, 66, 69, 70, 72, 74 are related to the latter topic.

4. Theme 4 – Technologies and innovations impacts on the organization and the supply chain:

The advent of the so-called fourth industrial revolution has led many companies to invest heavily in new technologies with significant and often underestimated impacts on the organization and the supply chain. The research related to this theme has been mainly exploratory but has allowed starting new collaborations between different scientific disciplinary sectors and between different countries. Publications 6, 8, 19, 24, 27, 34, 38, 57, 64, 67, 72, 73 are related to this topic.

In summary, the following table shows the number of articles (total and in journals) produced for each research topic and the main research methodologies adopted.
